Add changing facilities by paddling pool (e.g. with toilet block re-location)		
Add cycle racks to car park		
Add new signage for visitors		
Add soak-aways to areas with perennial drainage problems e.g. informal path from the Cherry Hinton Road pelican crossing		
Additional seating		
Better screening for the recycling centre		
Bird boxes and bat boxes or wildlife area		
Clean out of the brook area from the duck pond to the Daws Lane grille		
Cut back shrubbery by the side of garden to rear of Hall		
Daws Lane litter pick & tidy		
Ecological study for duck pond water and water's edge to see if habitats are free from contamination, with action to remove rats and/or signage to ward of dangers		
Extra posts or shrubs for turning bay in front of school		
Finishing and making good / more topsoil to grassed area near green double gates leading from the now defunct propagation centre (area first ruined in 2002 Festival)		
Formalise path from Cherry Hinton Road pelican crossing		
Garden area / competition for what to do near the tumblers statue (where lack of daylight and heavy use are unlikely to let grass grow)		
General improvement of access and facilities for people with disabilities		
Improve lighting where required		
Incorporation of café		
Ivy and elder cleared from two trees in south east corner		
Ivy clearance from trees along Walpole Road stretch		
New 'No Fishing' signs by duck pond		
New 'no motorcycles' signs		
New fencing / protection to the wildlife area to prevent human intrusion in at least part of the area		
New path from play area / Walpole Road gate to Recycling centre.		
Night time security including main gates locked each evening		
Reinstate path running parallel to Walpole Road		
Relocate the toilet block nearer to the paddling pool area		
Remove tarmac (excess from bicycle hoop installation dumped in grass at south end of path from paddling pool) and burn-off (near gate to Daws Lane where drainage recently installed) - and replace with soil		

Repair of path leading from the duck pond towards Daws Lane (including raising path up)		
Temporary surface to duck pond area		
Use of additional topsoil to level areas sunken by repeat use as walkways / driveways during Festivals		
Wooden edging to some of the paths
